PCANZ General Assembly 2025

This week on October 20th – 23rd Reece Frith and Barbara Carston will be attending the PCANZ General Assembly as commissioners in Christchurch. I realise that this system of governance may be foreign for many of you so a little background might be helpful.

The General Assembly meets every two years and is the highest level of governance for the Presbyterian Church in New Zealand. It sets the policy and the direction of the church as a whole, as well as approving the various regulations that help the church to operate as an effective organisation. Decisions made at GA are binding on all Presbyterian churches therefore it is vital that ministers and elders attend these occasions. In meeting to discuss, pray and even debate each commissioner seeks to discern God's will for His Church and make decisions accordingly. (The basis for style of governance is based on Acts 15:1 - 31).
